

# TOURS OF JEWISH WROCLAW



Our excursions are stories woven into the topography of Wrocław, tales of its inhabitants who contributed to the city's social status and respected position in the region and throughout the world. They will present the personal history of Nobel Prize winners, philosophers, architects, and the founders of the most prominent movements in modern Judaism but also that of members of the Jewish community and their daily lives.

The Jewish community invites you on a journey spanning 800 years of Jewish history inscribed on the walls of the most representative buildings, squares and monuments in Wrocław.

## Our tour guides:

- Acquired their knowledge of Jewish history in the best Jewish Studies programs in Europe
- Are the only guides authorised to give tours of both synagogues and the Jewish community buildings
- Are actively involved in the local Jewish community with a working knowledge of its history and current issues

## Excursion Program:

The excursion program was developed by a team of Judaic scholars and historians specially appointed to tell a coherent narrative beginning with Jewish settlement in Wrocław and ending with current events.

## Excursion Offers:

### Walk no. 1:

#### Jewish History from the Middle Ages to the Present

Beginning at the University Square, passing through the Old Town, visiting the White Stork Synagogue and the Little Synagogue, entering the ritual bath (adult tourists only) then going to Łąkowa street to see the monument of the New Synagogue that was burned down during Kristallnacht in 1938, and ending on Świdnicka street next to the Polish Theater (former Jewish Theater).

**Duration: 2.5 hours**

### Walk no. 2:

#### Jewish History from the Middle Ages to the Present – the Short Version

Beginning at the University Square, passing through the Old Town, visiting the White Stork Synagogue and the Little Synagogue, entering the ritual bath (adult tourists only).

**Duration: 1.5 hours**

### Walk no. 3:

#### Visiting the White Stork Synagogue (Museum Lesson with a Guide)

An hour-long museum lesson with a guide in the White Stork Synagogue and the Little Synagogue, presenting the history of the Jewish community in Wrocław.

**Duration: 45 minutes**

### Walk no. 4:

#### The Old Jewish Cemetery on Ślężna Street

A walk through the beautiful necropolis and resting place of Wrocław's most outstanding Jewish individuals. The cemetery is both a unique architectural site as well as a fascinating map of the history of the Jewish community of the city. (Visiting the cemetery may be combined with any other tour)
